We will regularly consult with our colleagues and representatives of employee health and safety, while encouraging participation to embed this culture of responsibility. It is our aim to be industry leading in health and safety best practice and innovation.

In line with our Health and Safety protocols, to ensure the safety of our employees as well as the people with whom the organisation comes into contact, we will seek to identify hazards and actively work to reduce their risks. We will seek to ensure that our vessels are maintained and operated by qualified personnel, and as a minimum, all our workplaces will comply with relevant health and safety legislation, and any other applicable standards, as well as meeting all requirements of ISO45001.

We will audit our workplaces to ensure these standards are maintained in line with our Health and Safety protocols and will seek to ensure that all employees have received the appropriate training, have the right tools and equipment to do their respective jobs safely and that they understand their own responsibilities. In addition, we will strive to continuously improve the safety management skills of personnel ashore and aboard vessels, including preparing for emergencies related both to safety and environmental protection.

We will set health and safety objectives for our business; these will be communicated openly and will be used to drive continuous improvement.
